



LOUIS combines the resources of Louisiana's public and private academic libraries, along with a centralized support staff, to produce a dynamic library consortium which provides library automation services to consortium members. Established in 1992 by the Louisiana Board of Regents, **LOUIS** has 47 members, provides services to over 250,000 students, faculty, and staff, with a \$3M annual budget.

Integrated Library Services

LOUIS hosts and supports the automation of library services for 29 academic libraries with 9 million titles. Each library is autonomous with its own branding, policies, data, and processes. The system processes over 100 million transactions and 200,000 reports each year.

E-Subscriptions

Focusing on full-text, LOUIS spends \$2M annually to license electronic resources for its members. LOUIS also supports members with unique subscription needs by providing negotiation and contract services. Over 6 million searches are processed against the subscriptions annually.

Interlibrary Loan

LOUIS supports the automation of interlibrary loan functions for member libraries. Patrons submit and track their requests electronically and receive electronic notification when their materials arrive or are due. Over 300,000 transactions are processed yearly.

Digital Library

LOUIS hosts and supports the digital library infrastructure for its members. The LOUISiana Digital Library is an online gallery containing unique cultural and historical resources of Louisiana's libraries, archives, museums, and other cultural institutions. Over 60,000 items are available.

Federated/Metadata Searching

LOUIS offers members a federated search engine which allows users to search across any or all of a library's electronic resources from a single web interface.

Authentication

LOUIS provides an encrypted authentication mechanism to protect access to electronic resources. This service authorizes patrons to access electronic resources from off-campus.

Link Resolving

After a user searches a library electronic resource, this service guides the user from a citation to a list of possible sources for accessing full-text copies of the actual material.

LOUISiana Union Catalog

LOUIS provides users with the capability to view and search the holdings of all Louisiana academic libraries using a single web interface. Combined collections in the virtual LOUISiana Union Catalog total over 14.5 million items.

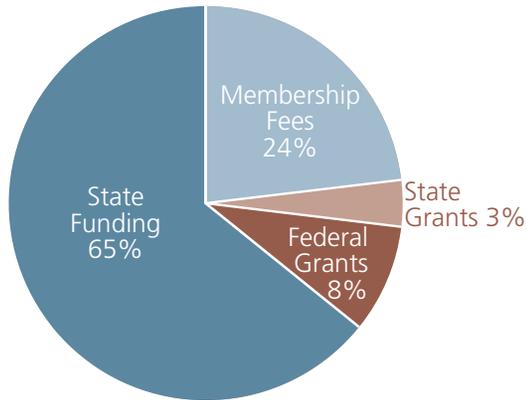

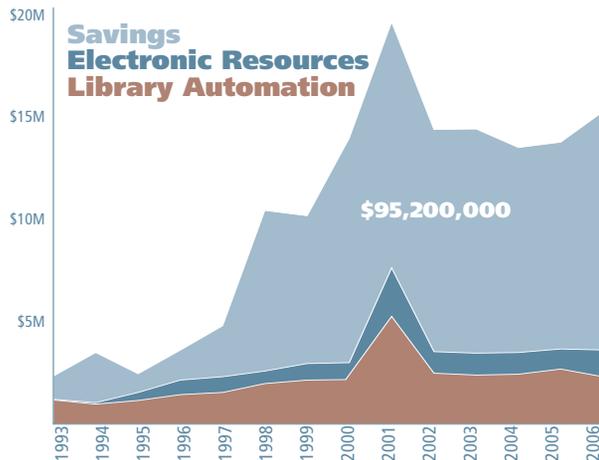
Funding

LOUIS was initially funded by a Louisiana Board of Regents enhancement grant in 1992. Based on the success of this grant, LOUIS was awarded additional state and federal grants to expand the services of LOUIS. Since 1995, the Board of Regents and LOUIS members have funded LOUIS. A total of \$49M has been invested in LOUIS since its inception.



Impact

Supporting library services with a central staff has saved Louisiana millions. If each LOUIS member had contracted for equivalent services as independent libraries, an additional \$95M, over and above the \$49M LOUIS investment, would have been spent. LOUIS has helped "level the playing field" by providing services to all Louisiana academic libraries regardless of size and/or institutional funding.
